The Bharat Scouts and Guides is a nationally recognized youth movement that promotes character building, discipline, patriotism, and leadership among young students.

About Bharat Scouts and Guides

The Bharat Scouts and Guides is the national Scouting and Guiding association of India, affiliated with the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM) and the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS). It focuses on the all-round development of students through structured training and outdoor activities.

The emblem of the Bharat Scouts and Guides features the international Fleur-de-lis superimposed by the Trefoil (representing the Guide wing) with the Ashoka Chakra in its center. The Ashoka Chakra symbolizes India, while the Fleur-de-lis represents the Scout wing.



The motto of the Bharat Scouts and Guides is "**Be Prepared**"

About the Founder – Lord Baden-Powell

The Scouts movement was founded in 1907 by Lord Robert Baden-Powell, a British Army officer who believed in shaping young minds through outdoor activities, skill-building, and service to society.

About the Course

The various stages of training imparted to the members of the program:

For Scouts and Guides (Ages 10–17)

1. **Pravesh (Entry Level) – (tentatively will commence in August 2025)**
 - Introduction to the movement.
2. **Pratham Sopan (First Step)**
 - Basic knowledge of Scouting/Guiding.
3. **Dwitiya Sopan (Second Step)**
 - Intermediate level with more skills.
4. **Tritiya Sopan (Third Step)**
 - Higher level, includes public service and leadership.
5. **Rajya Puraskar (State Award)**

- Prestigious award at the state level.

6. **President's Award (Rashtrapati Award)**

- The highest honor for Scouts/Guides in India.
- Requires rigorous training and community service.

Benefits for Students

Participation in the Scouts and Guides program provides students with a wide range of personal and social benefits, including:

- Leadership and teamwork development
- Discipline and a sense of responsibility
- Improved self-confidence and communication skills
- Respect for nature and the environment
