WHAT DO SPIDER PLANTS NEED?

- 1) Indirect Sunlight - If put under direct sunlight, the leaves dry up very fast!
- 2) Water when the soil feels dry - Usually once a week.
- 3) Trim the brown tips when the leaves get dry.
- 4) Fresh air - It loves good airflow!



ECOLOGICAL BENEFITS

- 1) Purifies the air around you by absorbing CO₂ and releasing O₂.

- 3) Regulates temperature by releasing moisture from its leaves.
