- COMMON NAME- black plum/ java plum
- BOTANICAL NAME: syzygium cumini

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- ► WATERING: water regularly, especially in hot weather. Keep the soil moist but not soggy
- ► SUNLIGHT: prefers full sunlight, grows well outdoors
- ▶ SOIL: grows best in well-drained, loamy soil
- FERTILIZER: organic compost once a month helps it thrive
- ▶ POT SIZE: use a deep pot to allow root growth if growing in a container.
