

Drumstick (*Moringa oleifera*)

Care Instructions

- Requires full sunlight and well-drained soil.
- Water moderately; avoid overwatering.
- Prune regularly to promote growth.
- Grows well in tropical and subtropical climates.

Ecological Benefits

- Leaves enrich soil as green manure.
- Provides shade and reduces soil erosion.
- Acts as a natural pesticide due to antibacterial properties.

Other Interesting Details

- Known as the "*Miracle Tree*" due to its high nutritional value.
 - Every part (leaves, pods, seeds) is used in cooking or medicine.
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Tamarind (*Tamarindus indica*)

Care Instructions

- Needs full sun and deep, loamy soil.
- Water during dry periods but is drought-tolerant once established.
- Mulch around base to retain moisture.
- Avoid waterlogging.

Ecological Benefits

- Fixes nitrogen in the soil.
- Provides habitat and food for birds and pollinators.
- Its dense canopy helps in carbon sequestration.

Other Interesting Details

- Tamarind pulp is used in cuisines worldwide.
 - The wood is strong and used for furniture and tools.
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Rosemary (*Salvia Rosmarinus*)

Care Instructions

- Prefers well-drained, sandy soil and full sunlight.

- Water only when soil is dry.
- Trim regularly to maintain shape and encourage bushy growth.

Ecological Benefits

- Attracts bees and other pollinators.
- Acts as a companion plant deterring harmful insects.
- Drought-tolerant and low maintenance.

Other Interesting Details

- Aromatic leaves used in cooking and herbal remedies.
- Symbol of remembrance and used in ceremonial traditions.
