Importance of Classroom Rules

1. Promote Safety-

Kindergarteners are still learning about personal space and how to interact kindly with others. Simple rules like 'walk inside' and 'keep hands to yourself' help everyone stay safe and feel comfortable in the classroom.

2. Build Routine and Structure-

2. "Listening Ears Are Ready!" We listen carefully when someone is speaking so we can learn and show respect.

3. **"Quiet Mouths Help Us Hear!"** - When we use our quiet voices, everyone can listen, learn, and feel safe. We take turns talking and use calm, kind words.

Chant in classroom- Quiet mouth, listening ears,

4. **"Walking Feet Keep Us Safe!"** - In our classroom and hallways, we use walking feet so no one gets hurt.

Chant in classroom- Walking feet,
nice and slow,
That's the way we safely go!

5. "Raise your hand to speak."
We raise our hands so everyone gets a chance to speak and be heard.

Chant in classroom-Raise your hand, wait your turn,
That's how we all get a chance to learn!



6. "Sitting Smart Helps Us Start!"-We sit with calm bodies and ready-to-learn

Chant in classroom-Criss-cross, applesauce, hands in your lap,
Eyes up front, give your brain a clap!



7. "Share with others."- We take turns and share so everyone can learn and have fun together. When we share we show kindness and make friends.

Chant in classroom-We take turns and we play fair,
In our class, we love to share!

Thank you for being our partners in creating a caring and respectful learning space for all children!

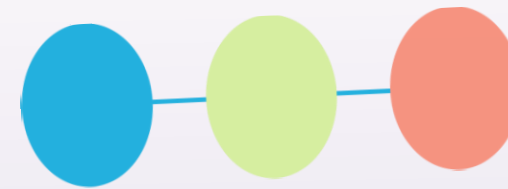
