ESSENTIAL BRIEFING FOR THE ANNUAL DAY PARTICIPANTS

- Only participating students should report to school at 7.30 am on the day of the event.
- Parents are required to collect their wards from their respective classrooms after 12:15 p.m. at the end of the programme.
- Please ensure that your ward carries a water bottle and light dry snacks as per his/her need.
- Shampoo your child's hair to remove oil. Light make-up (foundation, eyeliner, eye-shadow, blush-on, lipstick) and hairstyling must be done at home. Only touch-up will be done at school. All students must carry a comb, safety pins, and a napkin.
- Girls must have their hair tied in a ponytail. Girls with short hair must wear a black hairband. No accessories are allowed—only black hair clips may be used.
- Students must not wear any gold/silver jewellery or accessories. The school will not be responsible for the loss of such items.
- Parents are sincerely requested not to approach the CM or school administration for early exit. Your cooperation is highly appreciated.
- The school canteen will remain open on Saturday for parents.
- Parents are requested to collect their wards from their respective classrooms. Kindly be patient and follow instructions during dispersal at **12:15 p.m.** Only one parent from each family may go to the classroom to avoid crowding in the corridors.
- In case of any queries, please send a WhatsApp text to the CM. They will respond as soon as they are available.
- Parents are requested not to click photographs during the programme, as a professional photographer has been arranged. Please keep your mobile phones on silent mode during the event.
