Students are required to follow the given guidelines for the Board Practical Examinations:

- Students are required to be in full and regular school uniform, ensuring they are well-groomed. PE uniforms and sports shoes are not permitted, except for PE practical exams.
- Lab coats are essential for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology practicals and must be worn by students during these examination sessions.
- They should report to the lab/classroom 15 minutes before the scheduled time given in the date sheet to appear for the exam.
- They shall carry ONLY a transparent pouch/1 geometry box and a water bottle.
- The following items are banned in the examination rooms:
 - Any stationery items such as textual material (printed or written), bits of paper, calculator (candidates with learning disability ie. Dyscalculia are permitted to use the calculator as per Circular No. CBSE/COORD/2020 dated 20.1.2020), Pen Drives, Log Table (shall be provided by the centers), electronic pen/scanner etc.
 - Any communication device such as Mobile Phones, Bluetooth, Earphones, microphones, Pager, Health Band, Camera etc..
 - Other items such as Wallets, Goggles, Handbags, Pouches etc.
 - Any eatables opened or packed, except for diabetic candidates
 - Any other items that could be used for unfair means of attempting the examination.
- Parents are requested to make their transport arrangements for picking up their children according to the provided schedule. Otherwise, the dispersal will follow the regular school timings.
