- Respect every member of the school community and cultivate a culture of gratitude.
- Embody and model the four core values: Cooperation, Responsibility, Respect, and Sportsmanship.
- Encourage all students to share ideas and contribute toward enhancing school life.
- Support fellow students and actively participate in community service initiatives.

Note:

At ISB, we strongly believe in providing leadership opportunities to all students. Therefore:

- A student elected/nominated to a particular position will serve for one academic year only in that role.
- The same student cannot contest for the same portfolio the following year.
- However, they are welcome to apply for a different portfolio in subsequent years.
- Reapplication for the same position is allowed after a gap of one academic year.

Qualities We Look for in Student Council Candidates:

- Demonstrates positive leadership and serves as a role model for peers.
- Shows a strong work ethic and completes tasks with sincerity and dedication.
- Possesses excellent communication skills – both written and verbal, along with confident body language.
- Takes responsibility for actions and decisions, and is accountable to their role.
- Displays a positive and respectful attitude toward the school community.
- Manages time wisely, balancing academic duties with council commitments.
- Actively participates in extracurricular activities, including those held beyond school hours, showing commitment and enthusiasm.

Shortlisting Criteria for Student Council Nominees

- The student must have completed **at least one full academic year** at Indian School Bousher (from April 2025 to March 2026).
- **Parental consent** must be submitted along with the nomination.
- A **minimum academic score of 70%** in the past academic years is required.
- Active **participation and notable achievements in co-curricular activities** will be considered.
- Prior **volunteering experience** in school events or programs will add value.
- The student's **discipline record, attendance, and punctuality** will be reviewed.
- Evaluation of **overall personality**, including dressing, grooming, and presentation.
- **Health and physical fitness** will be considered.
- **Fee payment status** must be up to date.

- Possession of other **leadership qualities and desirable traits** expected in a student leader.

Loss or Termination of Student Council Membership:

Student Council members are expected to uphold high standards of conduct, commitment, and performance. Failure to meet these expectations may result in disciplinary action or removal from the Council. Grounds for termination include:

- **Scoring below 60%** in term-end assessments.
- **Disrespectful behaviour** towards facilitators, fellow council members, students, or support staff.
- **Attendance falling below 75%.**
- **Pending fee payments** for more than one quarter.
- **Lack of dedication** or seriousness in fulfilling assigned responsibilities.
- **Neglecting or failing to perform duties** as a Student Council Representative.
- **Misconduct or inappropriate behaviour** while representing the school.
- **Any action that damages the reputation of the school or is inconsistent with the values expected of student leaders.**
