Annual Academic Awards (AY 2025–2026)

- **Bousherian Pride** (*Scholastics & Co-Scholastics*)
- **Academic Excellence** (*Scholastics*)
- **Academic Proficiency** (*Scholastics*)

Note: A student is eligible to receive only one of the above awards. *Bousherian Pride* holds the highest distinction and will be given preference where applicable.

Eligibility Criteria

Bousherian Pride (Maximum 5 students)

- Must have appeared for all assessments conducted during the academic year.
- All assessments must have been taken offline.
- Minimum overall percentage: **93% and above** in the core subjects.
- Skill subjects / 6th subject will not be considered for the overall percentage calculation.

Grade 10	For Grade 9	English, Second Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Science
Grade 11	For Grade 10	Board exam result will be considered
Grades 12	For Grade 11	English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Computer Science, Accountancy, Economics, Business Studies, Marketing, Psychology, Physical Education, Information Practices
Outgoing 12	For passed out Grade 12	Board exam result will be considered

- Active participation in at least **4 House events**.
- Achievement in competitions:
 - Secured at least **two top positions (First/Second)** in Inter-House competitions across **two different categories** (Literary, Cultural, Sports).
- Leadership role (School Council) will be considered in case of a tie.
- Participation/achievement in **CBSE Cluster, National/International, or Inter-School events**.
- Notable contribution in **Annual Day, BOD Events, school celebrations, and assemblies**.

Academic Excellence (Top 3 students only)

- Must have appeared for all assessments conducted during the academic year.
- All assessments must have been taken offline.
- Minimum overall aggregate: 93% and above (no rounding off permitted).
- Must be among the top three rank holders in the respective grade.
- A minimum of 88% must be secured in each core subject and in every assessment.
- Skill subjects / 6th subject will not be considered for the overall percentage calculation.

Academic Proficiency (All eligible students)

- Must have appeared for all assessments conducted during the academic year.
- All assessments must have been taken offline.
- Minimum overall aggregate: **90% and above**.
- A minimum of 88% must be secured in each core subject and in every assessment.
- Skill subjects / 6th subject will not be considered for the overall percentage calculation.

General Criteria (Applicable to All Categories)

Students must demonstrate:


- Consistent discipline and good behavior.
