Subject: CBSE Post-Result Facilities – Scanned Copy, Verification & Re-evaluation

Dear Students,

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has introduced post-result facilities for Class XII students to ensure transparency and fairness in the evaluation process. Students who wish to review their performance in the Board Examination may avail themselves of the following facilities as per the CBSE guidelines.

Stages of the Process

Stage 1: Obtaining Scanned Copy of Evaluated Answer Book(s)

Students may apply online to obtain a **scanned copy of their evaluated answer script(s)**.

Schedule & Fee

Applying online for scanned copy of evaluated answer book(s)	19.05.2026 to 22.05.2026 (up to 11:59:59 PM)	Rs. 700/- per subject

Important Instructions

- Applications must be submitted **only by the candidate**.
- Applications submitted through third parties or cyber cafés are discouraged.
- Students may apply for **single or multiple subjects**, but the application must be submitted **in one attempt only**.
- Scanned copies will be made available through the candidate login portal.
- CBSE will provide scanned copies on a **first-come, first-served basis**.
- **Only students who apply for scanned copies of answer books will be eligible for the next stage.**

Stage 2: Verification of Issues Observed & Re-evaluation

After receiving the scanned copy of the answer book, students may apply online for:

- **Verification of marks/issues observed**
(*totalling, unevaluated answers, etc.*)
- **Re-evaluation of specific questions**

Important Instructions

- Only candidates who have obtained the scanned copy of answer books are eligible for verification/re-evaluation.
- Students must refer to the CBSE marking scheme available on the CBSE website before applying for re-evaluation.
- Applications for re-evaluation must specify the question number(s) along with valid reasoning.
- The status of requests will be updated in the candidate login portal.
- Marks may **increase or decrease**, even by one mark.
- The result declared after re-evaluation shall be **final and binding**, and no further appeal will be entertained.

Guidelines for Re-evaluation

To help students understand the re-evaluation process better, CBSE has suggested the following steps:

Before Applying

- Question papers are available on the CBSE website.
- The marking scheme for each set of question papers is also available on the CBSE website.

Students are advised to:

1. Download and keep a copy of the relevant question paper and marking scheme used in the examination.
2. Carefully compare the evaluated answer book with the official marking scheme.
3. Clearly identify any discrepancy where:
 - Marks may not have been awarded despite the answer matching the marking scheme, or
 - The response is similar to the marking scheme but no marks have been awarded.
4. Mention all observations clearly and specifically while applying for re-evaluation.
5. Submit information in a clear and organized manner so that the request can be understood and processed appropriately.

General Instructions

- The entire process is **online only**.
- Online applications may be submitted even on holidays.
- Applications must be submitted strictly **within the CBSE schedule**.
- **No offline or late applications will be accepted.**
- Fees must be paid **online only**.
- Only **one application per stage** is permitted.
- If marks change after re-evaluation, students must submit the **original marksheet** to receive the revised marksheet.

Important Notes

- The decision of CBSE regarding marks awarded shall be **final and binding**.
- Information submitted by students will be verified by CBSE experts, and corrections will be made only if the claim is found valid.
- A scanned copy of the evaluated answer book may also be obtained under the **RTI Act, 2005**, as per its provisions.
- However, requests for re-evaluation or grievances cannot be processed under RTI provisions.

Advisory to Students

- Apply only after careful consideration.
- Review scanned answer scripts thoroughly before applying for verification or re-evaluation.
- Ensure that all applications are submitted correctly within the stipulated timeline.
- Follow CBSE guidelines strictly to avoid rejection of applications.
