**Grade wise Topics and titles for Poster Making:** (Some helping slogans are also given)

**Grade-5 - जलस्य महत्त्वम् (Importance of Water)**

### Instructions for Poster Making:

1. Students may prepare materials for the poster border and collect or arrange pictures to be affixed on the poster at home. They are required to bring these materials to school and complete the poster during the Sanskrit lesson, block period, or Art classes in the coming days. The completed poster must be submitted to the Sanskrit Department in the **3rd Floor, A-Wing Staffroom** on or before **Sunday, 10th May 2026**.

2. The poster must be prepared on a **minimum A4 size sheet**.
3. Students should bring and use appropriate materials such as colors, pencils, sketch pens, etc.
4. Students are instructed to use Sanskrit captions and dialogues in the poster (in the bracket you can mention the same in English or any other regional language.) which may help students to give an opportunity to connect many languages and learn new words.

**Evaluation Criteria:**

1. **Border presentation**
2. **Aesthetic appeal** (colour combinations, drawings, creativity, etc.)
3. **Relevance to the theme**
4. **Clarity and effectiveness of the message/content**
5. **Overall neatness and handwriting**

The **best and selected posters** will be displayed in the **Admin Area** during the same week.  
**Certificates will be awarded to the winners of each category.**
