Dear Parents,

Greetings from Indian School Bousher!

We extend our warm wishes to all students for a happy, healthy, and successful academic term.

With the reopening of the school and the prevailing high summer temperatures, the safety, health, and well-being of our students remain our highest priority. **To ensure a safe, healthy, and comfortable learning environment, the school has implemented the following precautionary measures:**

- **Outdoor activities** have been restricted during periods of extreme heat. Morning assemblies, sports, physical education classes, and other outdoor programmes will be conducted only when weather conditions are favourable.
- **Students are encouraged to remain well hydrated** throughout the school day. Teachers will regularly remind students to drink water at frequent intervals.
- **Adequate chilled drinking water** is available across the campus through properly functioning water dispensers and coolers.
- **Strict drinking water hygiene** is maintained through periodic cleaning and sanitisation of water dispensers and storage tanks, along with the timely replacement of water filters.
- **Air-conditioning systems** in classrooms, laboratories, offices, common areas, and school buses are being regularly monitored and maintained to ensure efficient operation.
- **Electrical installations and air-conditioning** units are being inspected periodically to ensure safe and reliable functioning during the summer months.
- The **school clinic** is fully prepared to manage cases of dehydration, heat exhaustion, and other heat-related illnesses. Our staff members have been sensitised to identify symptoms and provide immediate first aid whenever required.
- **Students' exposure to direct sunlight** is minimised by ensuring orderly movement between buildings and limiting outdoor exposure during peak heat hours.
- **Special care** is being extended to younger children and students with medical conditions to ensure their safety and well-being.
- **School transport** is being closely monitored to ensure that all buses are properly air-conditioned and that students are not kept waiting inside parked buses before or after school hours.
- **All teaching and non-teaching staff**, including transport, housekeeping, and security personnel, have been briefed on summer safety precautions and emergency response procedures.

We also seek your valuable cooperation in ensuring that your child:

- **Carries a filled water bottle to school every day.**
- **Eats a healthy breakfast before leaving for school.**
- **Wears the prescribed school uniform and cap (where applicable).**
- **Gets adequate sleep and remains well hydrated before coming to school.**
- **Informs the class teacher immediately if he or she feels unwell at any time during the school day.**

We wish to assure you that the school is taking every possible measure to provide a safe and caring environment for all our students. We sincerely appreciate your continued support and cooperation in promoting the health and well-being of our children.
